An update was provided from Peterborough Public Health Unit regarding their support for the CPHA Position Statement on Unstructured Play; https://www.cpha.ca/unstructured-play. For School Councils, this means open endorsement & support for naturalization, diversity of play materials and sources to encourage more Loose Parts play and engage a greater range of accessible play spaces.
- **4.2. Shed:** Sonal spoke with Facilities Manager and suggested we invite him to attend the February Meeting. Discussion will continue in February about shed ideas: possible use of sea-can, steel container.
